Your union will be providing you with regular updates as bargaining progresses.

Over the next few days and in the coming weeks, your main job is to stay active and informed. Watch for bulletins in the workplace and check the website regularly.

Your strong support got us back to the table. Now we need you to do more. Take part in any activities that your local organizes to show support for your demands. Send a strong message to CPC that you want a decent collective agreement and you are prepared to strike if necessary to get one.
