Negotiations at Canada Post:

Union, Management agree on information blackout

Ottawa — The Union and Management at Canada Post have agreed on an information blackout regarding the negotiations currently underway between this corporation and its workers represented by the Union of Postal and Communications Employees (UPCE), a component of the 160,000 member Public Service Alliance of Canada (PSAC).

The parties are currently negotiating with a view to concluding a tentative agreement as quickly as possible.

Both sides agreed not to communicate with the media while the negotiations continue in an undisclosed Ottawa location.
