This meeting of Postal Unions from Germany, Austria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Hungary Serbia, and the Slovak Republic, meeting today, 27 November 2008 in Berlin, Germany, and who are members of UNI Post & Logistics Global Union, is shocked to hear that your company is planning on replace the sick leave and family leave with some inferior form of insurance cover.

We fully support the Canadian Union of Postal Employees (UPCE) in their justified struggle to oppose this totally unacceptable move by your company. We demand that you immediately stop the plans to replace the earned sick leave and family leave with a protection plan partly funded by insurance and partly funded by the Employment Insurance plan.


We are seriously concerned that a corporation like Canada Post could consider such a move to abandon your proper responsibilities and to place this burden partly on the tax payers of Canada.

We demand you drop this proposed action and immediately and work with the UPCE to keep Canada Post a fully public corporation.


