Negotiations with Canada Post to Begin this Week

Union Team Schedules Fifteen Bargaining Dates with Corporation through August

This week our elected PSAC/UPCE National Bargaining Team is scheduled to meet with Canada Post to commence negotiations for a new contract. To ensure that every effort be made to get to a contract before it's expiration at the end of August, our team proposed fifteen dates with the corporation through August, all of which have been agreed upon. Our first meeting with management is scheduled for this Wednesday, June 4th.

Our team has a package of demands that addresses core problems in Canada Post workplaces. This follows a worksite survey and input call process and our first National Bargaining Conference which was attended by Canada Post workers from across the country. We also conducted ratification meetings from coast to coast to coast. Our goal is to bring working conditions for PSAC/UPCE members in line with a number of key areas that Canada Post has already agreed to for other unionized employees working at the corporation.

We work for the same employer. We deserve nothing less than what is in place for other unionized Canada Post employees.
